If you have the book, please send in your comments pro and con, for the review. No names will be used. **I have the Token Price Guide in stock if you need one, \$80 postpaid.**

NOTE--as always, I use American terms and British pricing. At some point, to avoid confusion, now that we have a guide, I might start using the British grading along with the pricing. Comments welcome.

The Robbie Brown sale, part II, was very interesting indeed. A few new collectors were on hand, on the phone, and on the internet, and some of the prices realized were well above high estimate.
