**Medal, Chronology of the Royal Families of England,** 1066 to present, (present being 1837). Large format white metal medal, 99% bright, 64mm, **Very RARE** in this condition, with no pecking, \$185.

**Medal, Church and King club** of Manchester, 1790. King, Castle/ --the reverse, a complaint against the throne for the corporations act. Very interesting, **this a 47mm silver medal in a glass lunette** with a metal band surrounding, and a hanger on the top. Superb condition, encased as it is, about new!! \$435.

**Medal---Napoleon.** Wish I had a photo. This has Napoleon in a high pointed hat on the obverse, the hat rather obviously "attached" after the piece was struck, as it sticks out and has sharp folds, very unique---struck for, according to the reverse, the 3rd anniversary of the 1830 revolution. BZ, 57mm, Choice EF, \$295.

**Medal---Napoleon/Angel** consoling him St Helena during his exile, 1814. Bust to right, on this gilt bronze 39mm medal, the whole encased in a round wooden frame, 70mm. Made to be hung on a wall, as was custom in many households. Some damage to paint on frame, medal GVF, interesting piece \$85.

**Napoleon**---A Sentinel guarding the Tomb of Napoleon on Isle of Elbe. This in medallic form, gilt, on the lid of a snuff box. The box turned, might be rootwood, very nice condition, GVF, \$395.

**Box Medal**---Wellington's victories, by Toye. 2000 made in 1975, Wellington on lid/ Angel at tomb---this a commemorative box, 78mm, with two paste downs in lid and bottom, "The Battles of the British Army in Portugal and Spain" during the war with Napoleon. Also in the box 13 color roundels, with information of the battles, a most impressive production. A bit modern, but in as new condition, \$165.

**Medal--Bust Sam'l Fereday**/"A Friend to his country". By P. Wyon. Nicely accomplished, Fereday was a steel pioneer in early England, and a force in the industrial revolution. Medal from 1830's, Ch. UNC \$150.

**Cute Cat**---Little silver medal with hanger cat on one side, tea pot on the other, awarded by the Weekly Telegraph newspaper. Comes in a round, red 40mm box that is in very nice condition. All, \$45.

**Panama-Pacific Expo Opening Day Admittance** badge--(Feb 20, 1915)---Red, white, blue and gold 57mm badge, by Brunt Printing of S.F., with ribbon, and hanger "Participant". Nearly new, and RARE, \$115.

**Engraved coin**---very ornate vase of flowers, other designs, on a Counterfeit Geo III halfpence, the reverse dating it December 17th, 1790---London. Super work, \$125.

**Engraved anti Napoleon**---GP, Aug 12, 1803/ "Kill Boneparte for £20,000" on a George II halfpence. This work was done in 1803 when the fear of French invasion was high. Crude work, really neat-- unique \$225.

**Napoleon as senator, Silver** medals. 21mm and 14mm, 1801, original pieces. EF nice, \$95 for the pair.

**London Bridge**---29mm brass medal for opening of the bridge, Aug 1, 1851. Obverse pictorial, reverse with information about it--WITH a genuine piece of the stone from the bridge, gathered when it was torn down and shipped to Lake Havasu City, Arizona!! Medal EF and bright, stone genuine--- \$58 !!

**London Bridge**---Official medal-- William III/View of Bridge, AE 51mm. cpl obv spts, priced VF+ \$95

**Wine Tavern Token**---15th Century or before, pewter, 15mm, VF, with cross hatched designs each side \$57.

**Wine Tavern Token**---15th C, 13mm, Fine, Shield/hand wearing a gauntlet. \$48.

**Wine Tavern Token**---15th C, 13mm, GF, A Cross in a circle/ "E" in a circle. Strong piece, \$48.

**16th C lead token**---- 18mm, strong VF, 5 petal flower/Blank. \$35.

**16th C lead token**---17mm. A French Lis/ Blank. VF, \$23.

**17th C , or late 16th C**, 22mm pewter, Cockerell (Chicken)/ branch with leaves. VF and nice \$64.

**Rolls Royce factory tool tag**, Derby plant. Holed as made, 22 X 28 mm rectangle, \$15.

**Hudson's Bay Co**--- Eastern division aluminum token from 1900's, "HBC 5" /blank. \$75.

**USA**---Watch Fob, Shield of the USA, horse, sentinel, cannon, etc/Souvenir of **Fort Bliss, Texas, 1914**.

The troops trained there for entrance into **World War I**. EF, super piece, \$75.

**Bickford Dollar**. H&K 834, round, 28mm, bronze center and aluminum body. In 1896 Dana Bickford put out this piece to attempt to get the currency of Europe standardized, or at the very least to get the exchange rate standardized. This piece as new, full luster, you shall never find a better, **RARE thus**, and I guess you would call this the "**first attempt**" at what is now the Euro. Great piece---very choice UNC \$395.

**Amelia Earhart medal**, 28mm AE gilt, counterstamped on reverse "Presented by Arnold Constable & Co", this was issued for a parade celebration in 1928, but upon her disappearance it was canceled. . UNC, \$45.

**Suicide of Generaloberst Dr Ernst Udet**. Pilot in WWI, and general of the German Luftwaffe in WWII, he "committed Suicide" in 1941, and was replaced by Goering. The medal with bust of Udet/Two fighter planes, one being the ME262 jet of 1945. WM 36mm by **Goetz, K 590**. Choice UNC \$325 Very hard to find.

**Kettle Token**---Farthing size dies, halfpenny size flan, this a **pattern strike**, George III/Rampant Lion. The bust of George III much like the one used on a 50 year Jubilee medalet. Very neat piece, EF at least, \$350.

**Highland Agricultural Society**---44mm Silver medal, one of the neatest scenes on the obverse, that of a man and his dog sitting in front of sheep with a huge house in the background. Superb work. The reverse is named to John Kerr, in 1848. 44.7 grams of silver in this Scottish award medal. \$95.

**Christ's Hospital**--Early award medal. Edward VI/a book. An issued award for the year 1827. These pleasing medals are silver, 35mm, and this a nice AEF. \$120. For Conder tokens see Midd 1,2, 9-13, 278-281.

The English grading system is used on all tokens, but the grading abbreviations are USA. A plus or a minus next to a grade indicates that the piece is in the grade indicated, but look, surfaces, or marks may be a bit better or worse than the grade given. Scr= scratch. Hfs, =holed for suspension. Rm=rim nick. UNC—no wear. AU—Tad rub. EF— light circulation. VF-Very fine. F-Fine. VG Very good. G-Good.
