PENRYN 4. 1794. Dunstanville's Arms//Arms of the Penryn Volunteers. This a bronzed proof, in a slab marked MS64, a very nice one indeed. Ex Spingarn, with his envelope. \$335.

DEVONSHIRE

PLYMOUTH 6 1794 Woman, spinning wheel//Man in Loom. Nice UNC \$145.

EXETER 10 1792 Bishop Blaze//Arms of Exeter. Tad red, die rust lumps, Reverse near perfect, nice luster, obverse with wear at the highest points, luster. **RARE**, Net AU//UNC \$225.

ESSEX

COLCHESTER 10 1794 Colchester Castle/Loom. Dusky original luster, very nice UNC \$110.

DUNMOW BB 11 1793 Arms of Dunmow//A Flitch of Bacon. Full luster, Choice UNC. \$325
A flitch of bacon was awarded the couple in Dunmow who could prove to have not had a fight between them in the last year. How they managed to convince the town is another matter.

DUNMOW BB 11b 1793 As #11, but with the **RARE** plain edge. Gemmy UNC, just \$345.

HORNCHURCH 33 (ND) Edward IV//Arms of Hornchurch. Some red, luster, UNC \$145.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE #1-14 ARE PENNY TOKENS, the arms of Gloucester reverse of all.

GLOUCESTER 1 1797 Gloucester Cathedral few sm mks in obverse fields, AU \$135

GLOUCESTER 14 ND St. Mary De Lode Church, with buttresses. This one in **Copper**, by **Ottley** and very rare in that metal. This in a slab, MS63 brown, Super for an Ottley. \$325.

BADMINTON 43 ND Plough//Scales, 6 ½ LB.. Super surfaces, Luster, UNC \$165

NEWENT 64 1796 Apple Tree//Legend, circular pattern. **GEMMY** UNC \$245.

Another, essentially the same, the luster being all there but more subdued. \$195.

HAMPSHIRE

BASINGSTOKE 1 1789. a SHILLING VALUE---A Barge/A Wheelbarrow, with tools. Pinkerton Issue, used to pay the Navvies who hand dug the canal. Many thus found worn to some extent, nice examples can be hard to find. . This one with the slightest of rub, so very close to UNC, and with no marks, spots, etc, and full luster. A full UNC sold for over \$1000 recently, this one AU++ \$595.

EMSWORTH 13 1794 Bust Earl Howe//Britannia. Some red, some luster GEF/UNC \$65

EMSWORTH 15 1794 Earl Howe/Britannia, some red nice AU \$55.

Another, with multiple die cracks all around the reverse in many directions, Choice AU, better, \$125.

EMSWORTH 29 1795 Earl Howe// A Large Ship. Very nice for issue, EF/GEF \$75.

NEWPORT BB 46 1792 Bust Wilkins//An ancient Ship. In 20 years have seen but a couple of these with full hair detail, luster, and no problems. This is one of these two or so, today far rarer than many of the "made for collectors" pieces in high grade. Here it is, one minor flaw, as made, a rough spot in the flan at 10:00, affecting nothing, and the slight bump seen at 12:00 caused by the strike of the edge ornament, so no post strike problems. **One this grade very rare indeed.** \$325.

JERVIS 65 1797 Neptune, Chariot//Jervis legend. An UNC with 4 small obverse spots, otherwise nice, \$75. Another, 1 tiny spot, lots of luster, Fully UNC and sharp, \$145

PORTSEA 68 1794 Shield, Javelin//Ship. Partial lacquer, tad red, net AU \$95.

PORTSEA 79 1796 St. George, Dragon/Ship, fish. Luster, but overall light rub, EF+ \$95.

Naval Farthing 98 ND Lord Bridport//Anchor & cable. Red and brown, UNC \$275.

Naval Farthing 106 ND Earl Howe//Crown, &c. AU, \$125. Choice UNC, \$145.

The **RRR** 106a, Luster, full strike, plain edge UNC \$345.

HEREFORDSHIRE Penny Tokens

HEREFORD 1, 2, 3, 4---- all of these feature a bull breaking his chains//Apple tree reverse, 1796.

The 1 and 4 are the most common, the 2 and 3 the scarcest to rare. Here is a group of them—

#1 Few marks, nice color, nice strike, net EF \$225.

#2 Full luster, Brown gemmy UNC \$495. A VF, just wear and no marks, \$225.

#3 Nice surfaces, minor problems, weak on tree, nets EF+, **RARE**, \$355.

#4 Nice color, well struck, but many small bag marks. GVF net, \$185.

STORTFORD 4 1795 City Arms/River Scene. Nice Bronzed UNC, luster, \$175.

DEPTFORD 13 1795 Kentish men, William III//Stern of the Royal George. A pair bought at coinex, a nice AU, usual weaknesses, \$75, and an UNC, far better strike than usually seen. \$120.
 DIMCHURCH 15 1794 Justice Standing/Cypher. Usual slight weakness on the high points of the obverse, the reverse looks as new, the net look is EF/AU, These are scarce, \$135.
 GODDINGTON 25 ND A Griffin//blank. Cast, as always, this is a nice GVF, \$225
 GODDINGTON 26 ND I T (John Toke) Obverse, Reverse blank. Cast issue. Strong GVF \$185.
 GOUDHURST 28a 1794 Kentish Horse//Arms. Fuggles edge, counterstamped "F: F/VG \$55.
 GOUDHURST 28b 1794 Kentish Horse//Arms. Fuggles edge, strong strike, luster UNC \$165.
 GOUDHURST 29 1794 Kentish Horse/Arms. Myns edge. **Scarce**, this GEF, super \$125.
 HAWKHURST 30 1794 Cypher, wheat sheaf/Kentish horse in shield. Full choice UNC \$175.
 TENTERDEN 42 1796 Brewer's Arms//Horse and Drey. A token that suffers from weak strikes, this one only weak on the barrels on the cart. About as struck, nice UNC, and I nearly never can say that, the weaknesses usually downgrade it, but this one super. Price AU-UNC, a keeper, \$165.

LANCASHIRE**#1 Penny.**

HALLSALL 1 ND Arms of Halsall/ Halsall D. Edge engrailed. This is often spoken of as a piece that possibly predated the Anglesey Druids by around a year. A piece that seldom is found anywhere near UNC, here is one in a slab, AU58, perhaps a mark away from UNC, rare item \$295.

The reverse is the late die state, with two die cracks, one down the right side of the token, the other from the left rim at "O" and nearly to the crown in the center of the piece. Charming piece, the color underlying the luster is a faded red on both sides. Exceptional token, Choice UNC \$965.

 London and West. 81 1797 Bank of England//Arms of London Slab, MS63. Luster, nice \$395.

 London and West 108 1797 Skinner's Hall/Arms. Slab, MS64, very nice eye appeal, \$425.
 CLERKENWELL 154 ND Seat of David Garrick//Skidmore's. Choice surf, nice UNC \$295
 MISCELLANEOUS 173 1797 The House of Commons from the Thames/Cornucopia, Liberty cap. Slab, MS62 brown, and I know I am looking through plastic, but it looks better to me, \$325.
 POL-SOCIAL 205 1794 Bust Hardy//Names of his jury---super obverse, the rev GVF \$85.
 PAINE 208 ND Bust of Thomas Paine///the mountain in labor. These are always in white metal, and often are afflicted with tin pest. This one suffers a good deal from that. Taken in trade from an owner (8 years), who found a better, though still pested example. A decent one these days will run into 4 figures easily. . This one EF, but selling for VG price. Obverse: Fairly clear, but right in the center of the bust a large spot of pest, going up to the neck. The Rev with 4-5 smaller areas, one on the head of the standing figure. Price. \$295.
