Coronation of Wm IIII and Adelaide, Sept. 8, 1831. Obverse, bust of the King and Queen//Reverse, the crowning at Westminster--crown and scepters in ribbons. Red in the devices, quite a bit of original luster, easily EF, and \$135. **BUT-- AS THEY SAY, THERE IS MORE!!!!**

A TICKET-allowing the bearer into the Poet's Corner, Westminster Abbey---- to view the coronation of William IIII and Adelaide. This is a Dean and Chapter's ticket, for entrance in the South Vaultings, which includes the famous Poet's Corner. The ticket is signed by the Dean, John Ireland, with all proper and correct embossed stamps, for the Coronation 8 September 1831. The ticket is in wonderful condition, nicely wood framed, under glass, the frame also in super condition. Ready to be put on a wall, or shown as part of a display. Measures around 5 X 7 inches framed. A seldom found item, especially this nice. \$445. With above medal. the pair \$550.

A PLAQUE---measures roughly 6 1.2 X 6 inches, wood and in superb condition, with a bronze plate attached to it made from, "Copper from Admiral Nelson's Flagship". It features a large ship on the plate, that belonging to Nelson. This plaque made for sale by the British Sailor's Society, who did have access to copper from the ship, probably this is 1895 or shortly after. As new, \$155.

TOWER BRIDGE---The official medal, Copper, 76mm round, 7mm thick rim!! This with Queen Victoria, and the Prince and Princess of Wales on the obverse, a view of the new Tower Bridge on the reverse, "opened June 1894", A large medal for a major event, in superb condition, about as new. \$335.

OPENING OF THE NEW COAL EXCHANGE-- This is a very well made large medal, bronze, 89mm with an 8mm thick edge!!, busts of Victoria, Albert, and two children in separate circles, along with people standing in other openings on the obverse---the Reverse with a view of the interior of the exchange, including the dome. A very impressive building. Opened by Prince Albert on October 30, 1849. One tiny rim tick, otherwise as made, very nice \$345. Increasingly hard to find this nice.

QUEEN VICTORIA---45mm gilt 1837 Coronation medal. Fully gilt, one tiny bit of rub on her cheek. No wear, just a tad of the gilt missing Really very nice, quite a bit of original flash, so EF++ \$145.

IRELAND--WWII Air warden's Badge, Gilt bronze, 36mm round. Female with dog, and a protective staff///Reverse with legend, dated 1939-1946. With red and white ribbon, pin, all very nice, **RARE**, EF \$85.

LONDON---65mm X 120mm oval Market Porter's Arm Badge, for the Covent Garden Market. This circa 1900 or perhaps a bit after, White enamel, black lettering, Arms of London, #`1389, this with the original leather arm band and clasp. Interesting item--- VF at least, \$110.

SINKING OF THE LUSITANIA---The English copy, 1915, in Iron. A Skeleton sells tickets to the ship, the reverse with the ship sinking. A famous WWI sinking, by a German U-Boat. EF, \$55.

WWI---The German Army halted at Liege. A woman prisoner, naked and hands tied, looks at a German Eagle///Belgian Lion stands astride a tank, facing the town of Liege. BZ, 70mm, EF and nice \$115.

WWI---The Defeat of the German Fleet----at the Battle of Jutland. White Metal, 45mm, the obverse with two battle scenes, the Rev with the description of battle. May 31, 1916. Superb EF+ condition, luster \$78.

1808 India 20 Cash coin---struck by Boulton, for an order by the East India Company, and shipped on the Admiral Gardener---which sank in a storm off the coast of England. These were sea salvaged in 1984, with many being brought up. Some really original looking, others cleaned, none ever circulated. Each \$25.

Prince Edward Island, Fisheries token, PE 5 B-1. choice EF, some luster, hook in plough type, \$125.

Wellington----WE 11A-1 Bust Wellington//To Salamanca. 1812. Halfpenny. Much red, choice AU \$ 125.

Nova Scotia---NS 12. Man fishing, dog//ship. 1815 halfpenny. No marks, nice color, GF for wear, \$38.

Province of Canada, Bank Token trial strike, the obverse and reverse of a halfpenny bank token, St George, Dragon//Crown over anchor, &c, but NO legends, no date. Struck on penny flan, and probably a pocket piece at one time or another, as it is about VF+ for wear, but no damage. **Fairly rare**, \$175.

Newfoundland---NF 1C1, 1846. Rutherford's penny, Hanging fleece. Choice VF+ \$35.

Newfoundland---NF 1C2, 1846. Rutherford's penny, Hanging fleece, Strong Fine, \$25.

Lower Canada---LC 31C ND, Boquet Sou//value in wreath. Luster, super AU \$95.

Lower Canada---LC 32B ND (1830 to 1840), super surfaces, nice EF+ \$65.

Nova Scotia-----HS 2A4 `1824. George IV/Thistle, Penny. AEF, old gilding, great coin \$100.
