As many of you know, I have a fairly large collection of medals and tokens from the families of Matthew Boulton and James Watt. As I acquired the collection, I sold many of the duplicate pieces that came in, often finding it hard to figure out just which one to keep, as all were nice. I have been asked many times if I had any medals for sale, and the answer over the last few years has been no.

Recently, a customer who has purchased a good deal of material in this field from me decided to not keep the larger medals, and I have bought them back. As well, there are a few others from other sources. These are offered here, at the price paid originally, a couple have not been offered before all are very nice examples.

All are from the Boulton family, and will be sold with a letter of provenance.

1. Death Medal, Matthew Boulton. 63mm bronze. These were commemorative in nature, it took Matthew Robinson Boulton 10 years to "get it right" with many miss steps along the way. In 1819 he produced them. Most had plain edges, but ones for family and friends had a lettered edge. It has been guessed that around 75 were made with the lettered edge, which reads "Patricus Amicus M. R.B " (For my Father's Friends Matthew Robinson Boulton) followed by the date. Pieces destined for the family were in gold gilt shells. This one has one gilt and one coppered shell, (box), the piece as new but slightly wiped. . \$3500.

2. Same as last, full luster, nice medal in shells with silvering for the interior. Made for his father's friends, this one very nice, and the only one in the Boulton family group in silvered shells. \$2500.

3. This piece the same as the last, as new but no shells at all. It was in the family holdings, and has the lettered edge. Some luster, tad dampstain, \$550. Inexpensive genuine Boulton family piece with provenance.

4. Gustavius III--- 56mm Bronze Gustavius III of Sweden./Cherub, angel, urn and plinth. By Kuchler, and absolutely wonderful die work. As new, in copper shells. Beautiful! With letter of provenance. \$895.

5. 48mm bronze medal, Bust Count Suverow, who was known as the Liberator of Italy. The medal dated 1799, and is superb, with full luster and no wipe lines. There is one copper shell, that is silvered on the interior surface. One I would certainly keep, it is that nice, but there were two. \$900.

6. Proof 1 Pice coin, 1794, E. India Company, made by the Soho Mint. As new, A PROOF! . \$400.

Very little family owned material has been sold, this is an opportunity to be one of the few who has something that came directly from the Boulton family. It is the first group I have had to sell in quite a while.

Olivar Cromwell, (1658) made in 1773, EF \$38. William Beckford, EF 1773 \$38.

World War One----**George V** in military hat and garb/troops and cannon off to war. A 32mm WM medal, with ribbon and pin---Pretty piece, AEF \$32. **Another**, George V in Military garb,/names of allies, "United we Stand", this one AL 29mm and VF, \$18. Both at beginning of war in 1914 but undated.

WWI-- A button, complete and in good condition, with the Union Jack in color encased. 20mm, nice \$25.

WWI--28mm bronze medal, Bust of mayor of Brussels/A fighting Cock. 1914, beginning of war. EF \$28.

WWI--Belgium, AL 31mm, ribbon, hanger. 1914. Bust King of Belgium/Soldier's children fund. AEF \$22

Also one in Silver, hallmarked, EF \$45, and one in Bronze, EF \$28. All three, no ribbon last two, \$85.

WWI--Belgium ambulance service, 1914. 34x27mm AE, with hanger and loop. Wreath, with a mortar shell descending, and the words Ambulance Service 1914, flag of Belgium. Uniface, **VERY RARE** EF \$120.

WWI--A Doughboy facing/Lest we forget, casualties 268,204. 1918. Bz, 26mm. **RARE**, \$75.

Australia--50 years a commonwealth, 1901-1951. Bz 31mm. Man sowing seeds. EF, and super \$15.

WWI--25mm Silver medal, Apr 25 1915, landing at Gallipole. **RARE** item, ribbon and hanger, \$35.

Coronation-- George VI. Ship/Coronation show, at Piccadilly Plaza. May 1937. AL, 29mm AEF \$32.

Visit to open the North Dock-- 1881. Prince, Princess of Wales/Albion Newspaper, &c. EF, as made \$85.

WW II-- Neville Chamberlain, peace accord with Hitler, 35mm bz 1938. Bust in high relief/Olive Branch. Chamberlain returned to Britain to announce "peace in our time", having appeased Hitler by giving him permission to "annex" another country.. Expensive lesson, Hitler did not stop there. Near new, \$68.

WW II---Japanese occupation of the Philippines 1943 AE, 44mm. Busts of Laurel and Vargas, puppet rulers under the Japanese--Rising sun in a triangle. 1500 struck, seldom seen today. UNC \$250.

Ireland Communion Token, Presbyterian Church Ireland/"in remembrance of me" &c. Oval WM VF \$32.

Chinese Junk Keying, WM 27mm, 1848-- It arrived in Britain May 27. Superb , luster, EF or better, \$32.

London Bridge opening, 1831, WM 28mm. Arms of London/Commenced, opened, &c. GVF, \$42.

NY Theatre, Admit/1817. VF \$32. Most of these found in England, so easily might be British theatre.

Napoleon---41mm bz medal, Bust left/View of tomb. For return of Napoleon's body to Paris 1840. AEF \$85.

Document seal, electro, 19th c, of the lower die of a seal used at the US Embassy in Paris circa a date prior to 1810, and most likely in use much earlier according to Dr. Doty at the Smithsonian. The original die was used to emboss a "wafer" on a document. This a dark metal uniface electrotype of that die. **Ex. Rare** \$195.

Rollout of two new Boeing planes, the 757 in 1982, 37mm the 737-300 in 1984. 39mm, AE. Pair, EF \$28.

Cartwheel Twopence, 1797, Peck 1077. Not a restrike. About EF. One really tiny dig on the reverse, otherwise very nice indeed, nothing else to really report. AEF, just a bit of wear, \$395.

Thomas Paine---Portrait seal catalogued by Wedgwood museum. Signed on back. Unique? Ask. EF \$895.
