18th Century "CONDER" TOKENS

The Ohio Collection-----

Every token in Bell's Commercial Coins-----

Hi All, this is not a regular listing, but a rather special one. Many of the tokens listed here were purchased in the last three decades, over a period of time, and the latest one to join the collection seems to have been six years ago. Most were being looked for when there was no club for them, and the major auctions had not started. Thus, some were hard to find at all, as there really was not much of a base for them.

In the UK they were only around because of numbers---not many there collected them, though there were some avid fans. It seemed to me that most of the country did not know what they were, and did not seem to care. One fellow, when finding out what I was looking for, said to me "Oh, those modern things"---and to many in the UK the series was, in their long history, indeed rather modern.

We have certainly found that they are important pieces, historically, in many respects. The Conder token, known in the UK as 18th C Provincial pieces, were the first things struck by steam press, the first thing struck using a self-ejecting collar, and the first series collected heavily by anyone, anywhere. They contributed to the economy in the 1790's like no government issue could have. The tokens were there at the beginning of all those things and more, and often you will hear that more beautiful pieces simply do not exist even today. What they accomplished in the 1790's is truly amazing.

But, I digress. When this collection came my way it was easy to see it covered a lot of ground, through the book from beginning to end, and from junk to gem. But, it is interesting to see how people collected, and what they could find before the series really got popular. Thus, the Ohio collection, with notations, something indeed for everyone.

There is a bargain bin at the end of this list. Whether for your collection or for dealer stock, both the main list and the bargain list have some real value. Enjoy the view
