Tees Navigation--51mm White porcelain, 1831, fragile, with a few tics but all of them very minor, new channel to Newport/Ship. This a RARE item, and a survivor. Nearly EF \$45.

Air Raids on London--Searchlights over St. Paul's, 1940-41/ Tower of London, plane, Battle of Britain June 1944. Bronze, 57mm, very minor small stain. London's dark days. EF \$65

Germany--- Post WWI inflation period, nude fat man sits on bundle of Corn, ----this is commonly called the "Corn Jew" medal, bronze, 38mm, this AU \$45.

Germany---WWII, 40mm zinc SS "Führungshauptamt" mail tag, Nazi Eagle, EF--1941-45 \$110.

Germany, (1924) Silver 40mm medal, matte proof, Kai 459j, Zeppelin pictured over New York City /Count Von Zeppelin portrait. Commemorative, struck Karlsruhe mint 1963. Superb, 40mm \$125.

Germany, WWI, Count Von Zeppelin/Airship over Tower Bridge. Aug 17 1915. **RARE, EF silver** \$145.

Germany/France/England--WWI--Casualty medal. (Doughboy in hat)The price 268,204 casualties. This medal is rare enough, is 26mm with a hanger, made in 1918 right after the war. \$75.

George VI Coronation medals----Victoria, Australia, Bust King and Queen/Arms, kangaroo. EF++ \$26.

Coronation medal, Greenock, Bust King and Queen/Ship and Quay, workers with kegs. looped, EF \$28.

Lamination--29mm bz medal, souvenir of Paris, 1890, lamination coming off in front of bust but it is still attached, which is a rare thing to have especially over 100 years later. Medal EF, \$25.

Belgium--WWI-- looped for suspension, this irregular shaped 34/27mm medal is for the Ambulance service, and features a winged bomb being dropped, date 1914 on it, and through it a caduceus.Very unusual EF \$110

South Yorkshire, "St. Christopher" on obv./ Bawtry Motor Co on reverse, **Ford cars**, AL 39mm GF \$22

Bank Tokens---two 3 shilling Counterfeits, 1811, Copper, Fine \$35, and 1815 Copper, about fine, \$35.

Another, 4 holes, 1813, target practice, perhaps? \$10.Very crude!!

Military base token, High Wycombe, England --open mess, 25c brass 28mm GVF \$18.

Reckenmeister token, 15th-16th C Germany, Man at counting table/alphabet, &c. AE 27mm, VF(+) \$62.

Theatre at New York token, 1817--"Admit". GVF, \$32. Quite choice. These have been sold for years as an entrance ticket to the NY theatre, but I question it as most seem to be found in the UK.

France---pair of art worked 10 Centimes, early type, Empire type, carved with designs. Pair just \$12.

Cromwell shilling, counterfeit and should fool no one, (1655), WM type, glossy. \$10.

Wells Fargo badge--"Wells Fargo Express, San Francisco Cala" on badge, "Guard" above, heavy with the original pin. No date, but an early piece, fun item, very nice condition \$125.

Dover, England, Howmet Turbine Co medal, made from Vitallium, monoshell casting. 32mm

Celebrating 50 years, & wishing the USA a happy 200th birthday, 1976. Aircraft turbine mfg. EF \$25.

Earl's Court Ferris wheel--AE 32mm, View of wheel/information--would take 1200 riders at the same time.Have following dates, 1897 AU \$34, 1899 VF+ \$15, EF \$26, Ask for others, 1901,2, 3,, 4, and 5.
